<p><b>Results</b></p>	<p>The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions Preliminary and above. The Aussie Skate Calculation system will be used for all Aussie Skate levels.</p> <p>Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.</p>
<p><b>Event Officials</b></p>	<p>Judge/s, Technical Controller and/or Technical Specialist and Data Operator/Video Replay Operator for any scheduled events are by invitation.</p>
<p><b>Membership Requirements</b></p>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club (N/A). (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p>
<p><b>Insurance/Liability</b></p>	<p>All members of State Associations and The Aussie Skate Program are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA &amp; <b>Figure Skating Association of Tasmania</b> assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
<p><b>Eligibility to Compete</b></p>	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition close of entries date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Aussie Skate refer: <a href="#">ISA Communication101</a></p>
<p><b>Practice Sessions</b></p>	<p>Practice times are in public sessions or by arrangement with the Glenorchy Ice Rink. An Official Practice Session will be held by expression of interest. Date/time will be announced closer to the date.</p>

<b>Withdrawals</b>	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b><u>before the draw</u></b>. <b>No refund permitted after the draw.</b></p> <p><b>A 20% fee to cover costs may be deducted from the refund.</b></p>

<b>Other Music file notes</b>	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD (or other device as permitted).  <b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b>  Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.  The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>

OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY / VIDEOGRAPHY	
<p><b>PHOTOGRAPHY</b> An official photographer will be taking photos at the EVENT. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. Information will be provided regarding purchasing photos after the event.</p> <p>A question regarding consent to being photographed at the event and also regarding these photos being used for promotional purposes is included in your online entry form. If you DO NOT wish to be photographed, please indicate this on your online entry.</p> <p>If you indicate that you do not wish to be photographed, then the Official Photographer WILL NOT take any photos of you or your performance. Therefore, you will not have the opportunity to purchase photos after the event.</p>	<p><b>OFFICIAL VIDEOING OF THE EVENT</b></p> <p>FSAT will have an Official Videographer at the event. The videographer will individually film each skater and the videos will be uploaded on an online platform (Google Drive). To purchase your video, please indicate this on your online entry under "optional extras". Cost is \$5 for the link to your video.</p> <p>You will then be provided with the link to the Google Drive before the competition, where you will be able to access the video and download it.</p> <p>A question to consent to being filmed will be included in your online entry, please indicate if you consent to being filmed or not. If you do not consent, you will NOT be filmed and you will not have the option to purchase your video at a later date.</p>

**PRIVATE PHOTOGRAPHY**

For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is permitted in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.

All private photographers are required to only take photos of their own child, unless permission/consent given by of age skater or by the underage skater's parent/guardian. Private photographers must remain in the grandstand and take photos from there. NO private photographers by the rink side, this is reserved for the Official Photographer ONLY!

**PRIVATE VIDEOGRAPHY**

Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information / Registration desk on the day of the event.

**Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area. Please speak to the competition convenor on the day. VIDEOING OF PRACTICE SESSIONS AND OFFICIAL WARMUPS IS NOT PERMITTED.**

Individuals are only permitted to take videos of their child, unless permission/consent given by an of age skater or by the underage skater's parent/guardian.
